Conference news & notes

- This week's schedule includes three HHC contests, including a showcase game. Friday night, Pendleton Heights and Greenfield-Central meet up at Bankers Life Fieldhouse as part of an evening doubleheader. Also Friday, New Palestine visits Yorktown. Saturday sees Mt. Vernon travel to Delta.
- New Castle, ranked No. 1 in Class 3A, extended its school-record winning streak to start a season to 16 with a 3-0 week. Two wins were in conference. Tuesday night, the Trojans beat Greenfield-Central 73-55 behind Luke Bumbalough's 29 points and six assists, and 26 points and 15 rebounds from Mason Gillis. Matt Turner led G-C with 14 points. Friday, New Castle beat Yorktown 75-36. Gillis had 24 points and 11 boards. Niah Williamson added 14 points for NC. Matt Grimes led Yorktown with eight points.
- The week featured two other HHC games. Delta beat Pendleton Heights 44-43 Wednesday. Josh Bryan had 10 points and a key assist on the game-winning basket for the Eagles. Eli Pancol led PH with 16 points and five boards. On Saturday, Shelbyville beat Greenfield-Central 59-57. Brian Long had a double-double for G-C with 11 points and 10 rebounds. Turner had 15 points for the Cougars.
- Other key performances last week came from Bryan, who had 24 points in Delta's 56-38 Saturday win over Hagerstown. Mt. Vernon's Damari Gatewood had 21 points, a career-high eight rebounds and three assists in a 59-55 overtime loss to Hamilton Southeastern.

Mason Gillis, New Castle

Gillis had another monster week, with 87 points and 46 rebounds in three games – averaging 29 ppg and 15.3 rpg. Gillis had 26 points and 15 boards in an HHC win over Greenfield-Central, and followed with 24 points and 11 boards against Yorktown. Saturday, he had 27 points and 20 rebounds against Central Christian in a non-conference game.
