Conference news & notes

- New Palestine's split with Pendleton Heights clinched the HHC title for the Dragons. It is the Dragons' 11th HHC title and second in three years. The clincher was an 8-1 victory over Pendleton Heights in which Jack Walker struck out 14 in five innings. He and Cameron Pitzer combined for 17 strikeouts and allowed three hits. Walker also doubled twice.
- PH used a five-run fifth inning to win the first game over NP 9-7, giving the Dragons their first conference loss. Walker Stull was 3-for-3. Evan Douglas and Wyatt Douglas had two RBI each for PH.
- Second-place New Castle split with Shelbyville. The Trojans won the opener 8-2 behind Logan Cline's solo homer and two RBI from Triston Chesher. Rylan Huntley allowed one earned run in a complete-game win. In the nightcap, Shelbyville used a six-run first to take the lead. Lucas Stieneker homered and doubled and had three RBI for the Bears. Brock Blackwell was 4-for-5 with three RBI.
- Greenfield-Central moved into third place with a sweep of Mt. Vernon. The Cougars threw a shutout in Game 2 to win 6-0 after a 5-3 victory in the opener.
- Yorktown swept through the Delaware County Tourney, shutting out Wes-Del, Wapahani and Cowan by a combined score of 21-0. Sully Swingley pitched two shutouts for the Tigers.
- New Palestine is No. 4 in the Class 4A poll. New Castle is receiving votes in the 3A poll.
- This is the final week of the regular season. Four twinbills cap things off – Mt. Vernon at Yorktown, New Castle at New Palestine, Pendleton Heights at Delta and Shelbyville at Greenfield-Central.

Player of the Week

Jack Walker, New Palestine

Walker was 4-for-9 with 4 RBI over the week, including two doubles in the Dragons' victory over Pendleton Heights. He also fanned 14 on the mound in five innings in an 8-1 win.

Pitcher of the Week

Sully Swingley, Yorktown

Swingley was 2-0 over 11 innings, including a complete-game 2-hit shutout over Wapahani, to lead the Tigers to the Delaware County title. He had 13 strikeouts and one walk.
