Conference news & notes

- New Palestine won the Hoosier Heritage Conference title for the fifth consecutive year, finishing its regular season 24-1 and with 18 straight HHC wins with a 13-0 Friday win over Delta. Mt. Vernon and Yorktown finish tied for second at 5-2. Shelbyville and Pendleton Heights are tied for fourth at 4-3.
- Sectional play begins this week with HHC teams at four sites. In Class 4A, Greenfield-Central, Mt. Vernon and Pendleton Heights are all at PH, with G-C and PH meeting in Monday's opening round. Shelbyville is at East Central and opens against Columbus East. In Class 3A, Delta, New Castle and Yorktown all play at Hamilton Heights. Defending 3A state champion New Palestine hosts its own sectional.
- HHC teams finish the regular season with a 111-31 record against non-conference foes, a .781 winning percentage. Seven of the eight conference teams won at least 16 regular-season games.
- New Palestine and Yorktown are ranked 1-2 in the ICGSA Class 3A poll.
- New Palestine finishes the regular season with a state-record 64 homers. Ashley Prange leads the Dragons with 15.
- Riele Widmann and TeTe Hart homered for NP in a 13-0 win over Delta. Mackenzie Jones and Kaylea Bullock combined on the shutout.
- Yorktown moved into a second-place tie with an 8-2 Thursday win over Pendleton Heights. Reagan Cox was 4-for-4 and drove in four runs for the Tigers. Bri Bilbrey allowed three hits and no earned runs.
- PH beat New Castle 17-1 Tuesday. Chloe Closser was 3-for-3. Lauren Landes, Ally Hall and Kelsey Sturgeon each had two hits and two RBI for the Arabians.
