Cameron Tabor had 24 points and 10 boards in New Castle's contest against Warsaw.
- PH moved to the top of the HHC standings with a 76-41 victory over Shelbyville Friday. The Arabians are now 4-0 in league play.
- New Castle's Cameron Tabor was named an IBCA Player of the Week from Week 3 for her performance against Muncie Central and Delta. She had 35 points and 15 rebounds against Delta.
