Dec. 18-22: Luke Bumbalough, New Castle

Bumbalough scored 51 points against Mt. Vernon.

Dec. 24-29: Luke Dunn, Yorktown

Dunn tallied 50 points in two games, including a career-high 31 against Rising Sun.

Dec. 31-Jan. 5: Peyton Meadors, MV & Josh Bryan, D

Meadors had 27 points, 5 boards and hit 9-14 from the field against G-C. Bryan scored 30 points and added eight boards and four assists in the Eagles' victory over NP.

NEWS AND NOTES

- Mt. Vernon and Delta both took the lead in the HHC race over the last few weeks. MV moved to 3-0 with a victory over New Castle Dec. 21, then to 4-0 with Friday's 51-44 win over Greenfield-C. and Peyton Meadors' 27-point game and six assists from Keith Rupert. Gavin Rose had a 13-point, 14-rebound game for G-C, his second double-double of the week. Rose also had 13 points and 12 boards Monday against Knightstown at Bankers Life Fieldhouse.
- Delta moved to 2-0 in the conference and 10-0 overall Friday with a 64-48 win over New Palestine behind Josh Bryan's 30 points. Tyler Wilburn added 17 points for the Eagles. Matthew True and Maximus Gizzi led NP with 14 points each.
- Delta is now ranked No. 5 in the AP Class 3A poll.
- New Castle's Luke Bumbalough continues his strong play. After a 51-point outing against Mt. Vernon Dec. 21, he began the new year with 37 points on 12-20 shooting against Richmond, then tallied 35 points in a come-from-behind OT win at Connersville.
- New Palestine's Maximus Gizzi also had a big day during the holiday break, tallying a career-high 30 points in the Dragons' loss to Decatur Central.
- Zach Kuhn had 30 points and nine boards for Shelbyville in Saturday's 87-84 OT loss to Greensburg. D.J. Kramer added 21 and Josh Williams 18.
- Christian Jones had a solid week for Pendleton Heights as the Arabians went 2-1 at the Madison County Tournament. He averaged 14.7 points and 3.0 assists.

NEWS AND NOTES

- The outright HHC title will be on the line for New Palestine Friday night as the Dragons travel to Pendleton Heights. NP has already clinched a piece of the title but can win its first-ever outright title with a victory over PH. NP last won an HHC title in 1994, the conference's first year. With one loss, Mt. Vernon remains in contention.
- There was just one HHC game over the holiday break, with Yorktown beating Shelbyville 58-29 Saturday. Elizabeth Reece scored 30 points for the Tigers. She broke Yorktown's school record with eight 3-pointers.
- Lots of holiday tournament action over the break. New Palestine won its own invitational with wins over Greensburg and Noblesville. Leah Seib had 22 total points and Katie Herron 25 for the Dragons.
- Mt. Vernon went 2-1 at the Twin Lakes Invitational to finish third. Sydnee Perry had 12 in a win over Valpo. Greenfield-Central was second at the Franklin tournament. Delta was third at South Adams, with Brooklyn Matheny scoring 18 points in the Eagles' win over Eastside.
- Last week, Pendleton Heights finished third in the Madison County Tournament. Kailyn Graham averaged 14 ppg.
- New Palestine is ranked No. 15 in the IBCA single-class poll this week.
- Yorktown will host Delta in the Delaware County Tournament first round Tuesday.
