PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Zach Kuhn, Shelbyville

Kuhn helped lead the Golden Bears to a pair of victories with double-doubles. He tallied 26 points and 11 rebounds against Columbus East in a 77-60 victory Tuesday. He followed with 38 points and 12 boards against Hauser. Kuhn also had nine assists.

Matthew True, New Palestine

True tallied 22 points on 7-of-8 shooting - including 5-6 from 3-point range - and six boards to lead NP over Pendleton Heights. He followed with 23 against Mooresville.

NEWS AND NOTES

- Two conference games took place Friday. In one, New Castle holding off Greenfield-Central 63-53. Luke Bumbalough tallied 29 points and Mason Hardwick 17 in the New Castle victory over G-C. Gavin Rose had 12 points and six boards to lead three G-C players in double-figures.
- In the other, New Palestine moved to 3-1 in the HHC with a 71-65 victory over Pendleton Heights. Matthew True tallied 22 points and Maximus Gizzi 20 to lead NP. Gizzi also had eight assists. Damieon Warrum had 16 points and 10 boards for PH, while Tristan Ross tallied 19 for the Arabians.
- Delta rolled to the Delaware County Tournament title, beating Wapahani 66-53, Cowan 68-22 and Daleville 85-48. The Eagles are now 13-0 on the season. Josh Bryan scored 36 points in the title game and had 80 in the three-game tournament. Tyler Wilburn added 50 points and 15 rebounds in the three contests.
- This week's schedule features three conference games featuring six HHC teams. Delta opens play Wednesday against Pendleton Heights. Mt. Vernon, the other unbeaten in HHC play, is in non-conference play this weekend.
- Delta is ranked No. 4 in the AP Class 3A poll and No. 17 in the IBCA all-class poll.
- In other strong performances, G-C's Caleb Mundell had 23 points in a loss to Lapel.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Cameron Tabor, New Castle

Tabor tallied 29 points, seven rebounds, five assists and four steals in a victory over Greenfield-Central. She also had 21 points and 11 boards against Randolph Southern.

Leah Seib, New Palestine

Seib tallied 17 points and eight rebounds as the Dragons beat Pendleton Heights 52-40 Friday to clinch the outright HHC championship.

NEWS AND NOTES

- New Palestine clinched the outright HHC title Friday with a 52-40 victory over Pendleton Heights. The Dragons were led by 17 points and eight rebounds from Leah Seib in the victory. Haley Harrison added 13 points and Jordan Reid 10 for the Dragons. Leonie Wilson led PH with 11 points. The Arabians finish HHC play 4-3.
- The Dragons' title was their second HHC championship and the first since 1994. NP head coach Sarah Gizzi was a player on NP's 1994 conference title team.
- Also Friday, New Castle beat Greenfield-Central 67-43. Cameron Tabor led NC with 29 points. Karsen Morgan had 15 and Cloie York 11 for NC. Lydia McIntire led G-C with 19 points. Hannah Farrell had 12 points and 14 boards.
- Mt. Vernon improved to 3-1 in the HHC Monday with a 56-29 victory over Shelbyville. The Marauders have three conference games remaining.
- Delta won the Delaware County Tournament championship. The Eagles rallied from an 11-point deficit in the first round against Yorktown to win 27-25. Cassidy Dishman's eight points led Delta against Yorktown. Madison Delaney's 15 points led all scorers against Wes-Del. Dishman, Miranda Hart and Brooklyn Matheny all scored eight each in the title game win over Wapahani.
- New Palestine is ranked No. 19 in the IBCA single-class poll.
- The IHSAA tournament draw will be at 3:30 p.m. Sunday.
