PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Josh Bryan, Delta

Bryan scored 24 points and grabbed five boards as the Eagles beat Mt. Vernon 63-42 to take the HHC lead and improve to 17-0 on the season. Delta is now No. 2 in 3A.

Josh Williams, Shelbyville

Williams had 34 points and 18 rebounds in HHC wins over G-C and Yorktown. He had a double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds in the victory over Greenfield-Central. He had 18 points in the win over Yorktown.

NEWS AND NOTES

- Delta took sole possession of first place in the HHC Saturday with a 63-42 victory over Mt. Vernon. The victory extended the Eagles' best-ever start to 17-0. Josh Bryan had 24 points, while Brady Hunt had 15 points and seven rebounds. Delta shot 54 percent for the game. Peyton Meadors led MV with 13 points. MV is now second in the league at 4-1.
- New Palestine moved into a second-place tie in the HHC with a 65-41 win over Yorktown. Matthew True scored 20 points - his fifth straight game leading NP in scoring - and Maximus Gizzi added 17. MiLon McCowan led the Tigers with 10 points.
- Shelbyville went 2-0 on the week, beating Greenfield-Central 74-42 Wednesday and Yorktown 61-49 Saturday. Zach Kuhn had 21 points, Luke Asher 20 and Josh Williams 16 points and 10 boards against G-C. Jacob Cochran led G-C with 17 points. Against Yorktown, the Bears had three double-figure scorers, led by Williams' 18 points and eight boards and 15 points from Garrett Davis. Kuhn had 10 points, seven boards and eight assists. Walker Moore led the Tigers with 12 points.
- Friday, Pendleton Heights beat Greenfield-Central 66-57. Damieon Warrum tallied 23 points and eight boards, while Tristan Ross had 18 points and 11 rebounds for the Arabians. Brady Mundell had 22 points for G-C.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Cameron Tabor, New Castle

Tabor became New Castle's scoring leader with 30 points, nine boards and four assists in a win over MV, clinching a tie for second in the HHC. She has 1,570 career points.

Leah Seib, New Palestine

Seib tied her career high with 24 points in both of the Dragons' matchups last week, victories over Lawrence Central and Ritter, giving NP its first-ever 20-win season.

NEWS AND NOTES

- New Palestine finishes the season as the HHC champion with a 7-0 record and the school's first-ever 20-win season. Mt. Vernon and New Castle finished tied for second with 5-2 records. Pendleton Heights finished fourth at 4-3. It's the Dragons' second HHC title and first since 1994, the first year of the conference.
- HHC teams finished the season with a 76-48 record against non-conference competition this year, a .613 winning percentage.
- Sectional play begins this week with HHC teams at three sites. Greenfield-Central, Mt. Vernon, New Palestine and Pendleton Heights all meet in a 4A sectional at MV. New Castle will host a seven-team 3A sectional that also includes Delta and Yorktown. Shelbyville will travel to the Columbus East 4A sectional. None face conference foes in the opening round.
- Cameron Tabor became New Castle's career scoring leader last Tuesday in a win over Mt. Vernon. She now has 1,570 career points. In addition to Tabor's 30 points, Lexi Shelton scored 23 and Sydnee Perry 16 for MV in the Trojans' 51-50 win over the Marauders.
- Shelton had 17 points in MV's 43-31 win over Delta. Madison Delaney and Miranda Hart led the Eagles with nine each.
- Greenfield-Central beat Yorktown 48-31. Hannah Farrell had 17 points, Addie Hill 13 points/10 boards and Lydia McIntire 13 points for G-C. Ellie Miller had 13 points and Lea Alexander 12 for Yorktown.
- Among other outstanding performances, New Palestine's Megan Jolly had 10 assists in an 86-48 win over Lawrence Central. Shelbyville's Olivia Knarr had 32 points and 13 rebounds in two games, a loss to Triton Central and a win over Hauser.

SECTIONALS

4A at Mt. Vernon

A strong field includes half of the conference. Mt. Vernon - 17-5 and receiving votes in the ICGSA 4A poll - opens Tuesday against Connersville, while Greenfield-Central opens against Richmond. Pendleton Heights receives a bye and faces the MV/Connersville winner. Defending champion New Palestine - 20-2 and ranked No. 17 in the IBCA poll - awaits the G-C vs. Richmond winner.

4A at Columbus East

Shelbyville opens against Columbus North in a field that includes three 16-win teams - Columbus North, East Central and Bloomington South.

3A at New Castle

The host Trojans finished second in the HHC and open against Blackford. Delta awaits 17-win Jay County in the same half of the bracket. Yorktown is in the opposite bracket, opening against Hamilton Hts.
