PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Tyler Wilburn, Delta

Wilburn had 20 points on 7-8 from the field and 4-4 from the line to help the Eagles clinch a piece of the HHC title with a come-from-behind 61-55 win over New Castle.

Luke Bumbalough, New Castle

Bumbalough had a big week, scoring 41 against HSE and 34 against Delta.

Maximus Gizzi, New Palestine

Gizzi had 25 points and six assists in a 66-64 win over Shelbyville.

NEWS AND NOTES

- Ranked No. 1 in Class 3A, Delta clinched a piece of the HHC title Friday with a come-from-behind 61-55 win over New Castle. Delta has won its fifth HHC title and first since 2009, when the Eagles split the title with Mt. Vernon. The Eagles can clinch their first outright title since 1998 Friday with a win over Shelbyville.
- There are four conference games remaining on the schedule, including three this week.
- Josh Bryan scored 22 points and Tyler Wilburn 20 in Delta's win over New Castle. The Eagles rallied from a 10-point fourth quarter deficit.
- New Palestine and Mt. Vernon remain in the mix, as each has one HHC loss. They meet Friday at NP. Maximus Gizzi scored 25 points to lead the Dragons to a 66-64 win last Friday at Shelbyville. Zach Kuhn led the Golden Bears with 31 points.
- Among other top performances last week, NP's Matthew True scored 23 points on 7-9 3-point shooting Saturday in a 50-49 loss to Connersville. Reid Neal had 17 points, eight rebounds and two blocks for Yorktown in a 59-48 win over Wes-Del. Greenfield-Central's Jacob Cochran had 16 points on 6-10 shooting and five steals in a 58-38 win over Franklin County.
- The IHSAA sectional draw will be at 5 p.m. Sunday. It will be broadcast on IHSAAtv.org.
