Conference news & notes

- Pendleton Heights and New Palestine maintained the lead in the HHC with sweeps. Both teams now sport 5-1 records in the conference. PH plays Mt. Vernon this week. NP plays Greenfield-Central, which is one of two teams a game back at 4-2. New Castle, which also had a sweep last weekend and visits Yorktown this weekend, is also 4-2. Shelbyville visits Delta this Friday.
- Pendleton Heights rallied in the seventh to win Game 1 against Shelbyville 2-1, with Corbin Cox scoring both runs. PH then won the nightcap 10-1. Cox was 3-8 with three runs and three RBI on the day. Eston Stull had a four-hit game in the nightcap for PH.
- Sophomore Jack Walker hit .615 over the week with five RBI, helping lead New Palestine to a sweep in Friday's twinbill with Mt. Vernon.
- Yorktown earned a split with Greenfield-Central, led by Brady Horine, who drove in two runs and hit .455 over the week. Drey Jameson was 4-7 with three runs and two RBI in the doubleheader, and won his fourth straight start on the mound.
- New Castle swept Delta behind a shutout from Garrett Welch in Game 1 and a big week from Player of the Week Jared Heard.
- New Palestine is No. 4 in the IHSBCA 3A poll. Pendleton Heights is receiving votes in the 4A poll.
