Conference news & notes

- HHC teams went 13-3 in non-conference play, with each team winning at least one game and five teams starting 2-0. Last year, the HHC was 11-5 in the regular season and 14-9 overall in non-conference play. HHC play begins this week. The Helmet matchup features New Palestine at Yorktown.
- New Castle gave coach Kyle York his first varsity win, beating Rushville 43-26. Niah Williamson threw for five TDs and ranks among the state leaders in passing. Luke Bumbalough had his second straight 100-yard, four-TD receiving game. Williamson leads the state in passing yards and TDs. Bumbalough leads the state in receiving TDs.
- Luke Canfield had a big day for New Palestine, rushing for 275 yards and four TDs in a 61-7 victory over Richmond, extending the Dragons' regular-season win streak to 38 games. Zach Neligh threw for three TDs.
- Delta's Charlie Spegal had his second straight 200-yard game, rushing for 206 yards in the Eagles' win over Jay County. Other big rushing performances went to Shelby's Damon Lux (162 yards) and PH's Evan Douglas (168 yards)
- Yorktown's Reid Neal completed a 39-yard pass to Christian Hunt at the gun to finish a 26-20 win over Muncie Central.
- Mike Hoskins of Greenfield-Central had a big day in the receiving game against Bloomington North, with seven catches for 123 yards.

Players of the Week

Offense: Niah Williamson, New Castle

The state's passing leader, Williamson completed 35-51 passes for 345 yards and five TDs in a victory over Rushville.

Defense: Sam Lewis, Shelbyville

Lewis had five solo tackles, 10 total tackles, an interception in the end zone and also blocked a field goal in the closing seconds of a 17-16 win over Franklin.

Special Teams: Colby Jenkins, New Palestine

Jenkins averaged 37.3 yards per return in the Dragons' win over Richmond. He also scored four TDs on offense.
