Conference news & notes

- New Palestine and Mt. Vernon moved to the top of the conference last Friday in their league matchups. NP posted two six-inning sweeps of Yorktown by 10-0 and 13-3 scores to move to 4-0 in the league. MV beat Shelbyville 12-4 to improve to 3-0. The two teams meet Friday at MV.
- Friday's other include New Castle traveling to Delta, Pendleton Heights visiting Shelbyville and Yorktown at Greenfield-Central.
- For NP in its sweep of Yorktown, the winning pitcher was also the hitting star in each game. Jacob Garrison threw a four-hit shutout in the opener and hit his third homer in four days, collecting three hits and driving in five. In the nightcap, Jack Walker homered twice and was the winning pitcher.
- Friday was the night the lights went out in Fortville. The Mt. Vernon-Shelbyville second game was suspended due to a power failure in the seventh inning with MV leading 5-2. The game will be completed at the end of the season if it factors into the conference standings. In the opener, the Marauders' Dylan Cole and Dino Tharp both homered, combining to drive in seven runs.
- Greenfield-Central improved to 3-1 in league play with a sweep of Delta, winning 18-2 in five innings and 2-1. Adam Hutchison was 3-3 with two doubles, a homer and five RBI for G-C in the opener. Gavin Atwood also homered for G-C. Hutchison allowed no earned runs and three hits to win the nightcap.
- Weather wreaked havoc on the rest of the conference schedule. A doubleheader between Delta and Yorktown was scheduled for Monday, but postponed due to snowy conditions. The game is being made up Tuesday at Yorktown. Monday's scheduled Pendleton Heights at New Castle game has been moved to Wednesday.
