Conference news & notes

- The conference season is heating up. Last week featured six conference games, with New Palestine and Yorktown each winning twice in league play. NP (3-0) and Pendleton Heights (1-0) are the lone HHC unbeaten. This week features another busy schedule. Wednesday, Greenfield-Central travels to Yorktown. Thursday features two games – New Castle at Mt. Vernon and New Palestine at Shelbyville. Friday night, Greenfield-Central hosts Mt. Vernon under the lights.
- NP improved to 3-0 in the HHC with wins over two strong teams. In a matchup of 3A No. 1 vs. No. 2, NP beat Yorktown 15-8 Tuesday. Four Dragons homered, with Michaela Jones driving in three. Ainsley Phillips hit a grand slam for the Tigers. Jones homered twice Thursday in a 13-4 Dragon win over Mt. Vernon. Riley Hasseld was 4-4 for MV.
- Yorktown had two conference wins. The Tigers beat Delta 7-4 Wednesday behind Skyler Davis' three hits. Saturday, Yorktown beat Shelbyville 8-4, as Bri Bilbrey, Carlea Pettigrew and Regan Cox had two hits and two RBI each.
- Delta got its first conference win with a 7-1 victory over Greenfield-Central Tuesday. Cassidy Dishman homered for the Eagles.
- G-C rallied with a 10-6 win over New Castle the next day. Sam Kihega and Sydney Williams both homered for the Cougars.
- Pendleton Heights went 4-0 to win the Ben Davis Invitational, beating North Central. Twin Lakes, Perry Meridian and Ben Davis.
