Conference news & notes

- New Palestine moved to 4-0 in conference play with a 13-3 Thursday win over Shelbyville. Macy Miller homered and drove in three runs for the Dragons, whose 33-game winning streak was snapped by 4A No. 1 Center Grove in a classic back-and-forth battle the night before.
- Mt. Vernon moved to 3-1 with two wins on back-to-back nights. The Marauders beat New Castle 12-7 Thursday and Greenfield-Central 5-4 Friday. Cassidy Parker doubled twice and drove in four runs against New Castle, while Sydnee Perry homered. Cameron Tabor led NC with three hits and two RBI. Parker and Kaitlyn Nugent both homered at G-C. Sam Kihega doubled and had two RBI for the Cougars.
- In the other league game last week, Yorktown beat Greenfield-Central 13-6 Wednesday. Ainsley Phillips homered and had three RBI for the Tigers. Carlea Pettigrew also had three hits drove in three runs. Lexi Rankin homered for G-C.
- The HHC schedule is busy this week, featuring meetings of the league leaders. Mt. Vernon hosts Shelbyville Tuesday.
