Conference news & notes

- New Palestine solidified its hold on the conference lead with its fifth weekend sweep of the season, beating Delta 8-5 and 12-0. New Castle went 2-1 over the week – splitting with Mt. Vernon Saturday and beating Pendleton Heights Monday – to maintain second place at 7-3. NP can clinch a piece of the HHC title with a win Friday vs. Pendleton Heights.
- This week also features two other twinbills – Greenfield-Central visits Mt. Vernon in a matchup of teams in the top half of the league standings. New Castle travels to Shelbyville. Delta and Yorktown are idle from conference play as they compete in the Delaware County Tournament.
- New Palestine suffered its first loss of the season after a 16-game streak to open last Wednesday, but remains No. 2 in the IHSBCA Class 4A poll. The Dragons swept Delta 8-5 with a five-run seventh inning, and followed with a 12-0 win backed by Jack Walker's one-hit shutout. Ryan Fox led Delta with a strong outing, allowing two earned runs in 5 2/3 innings in Game 1.
- New Castle's 2-1 weekend was bolstered by 4-1 wins over Mt. Vernon and 4-2 over Pendleton Heights, sandwiched around an 18-9 loss in Game 2 vs. MV. Triston Chesher had two RBI in the Trojans' first win, Janson Anderson drove in all four runs vs. PH. Sam McCarty led MV with two RBI in Game 2. He hit .600 with four RBI over the week, in which MV went 4-1.
- Yorktown swept Shelbyville 7-3 and 14-7. Sully Swingley had five RBI and Graham Reedy three in the Tigers' two wins. Logan Miller and Lucas Steineker had four hits each for Shelbyville.
- Adam Hutchison threw a six-hit shutout to lead Greenfield-Central to a 7-0 win over Pendleton Heights in Game 2. Ben Richards' homer and Cole Miller's three hits led PH to a 4-2 Game 1 win.
- HHC teams have a .692 winning percentage (45-20) in non-conference games this season.
