Conference news & notes

- Three more HHC games remain on the schedule. Pendleton Heights visits New Castle Tuesday and hosts Yorktown Thursday. Friday, New Palestine hosts Delta. NP has clinched the HHC title outright.
- Greenfield-Central's 18-8 win over Mt. Vernon won the Cougar Classic title for the Cougars and was also head coach Jason Stewart's 250th victory.
- New Palestine broke its own state record for homers in a season Monday when the Dragons hit four in a 9-8 come-from-behind win over Greenwood. NP now has 61 homers, four more than last year's mark.
- TeAnn Bringle has set Shelbyville's single-season (11) and career (24) home run marks. Addison Weaver set the freshman record with eight homers.
- Pendleton Heights improved to 3-2 in the HHC with a 2-1 Monday win over Delta and a 7-6 victory over Greenfield-Central the next day. Jordan Benefiel had 11 Ks in the win over Delta. Kelsey Sturgeon homered and drove in three in the win over G-C. G-C's Madge Weidner had three hits, a homer and four RBI.
- Mt. Vernon clinched at least a share of second place with a 10-0 win over Delta. Tuesday. MV's Haley Kissee had two homers, a double and four RBI.
- Yorktown improved to 4-2 with a 16-8 Tuesday win over New Castle. Lexie Robertson hit three doubles for the Tigers.
- Shelbyville beat G-C 10-5 Wednesday to move to 4-3. Katie Mathies and Izzy Lewis each had two hits and three RBI for the Bears.
- New Castle took home hardware, beating DeKalb 5-4 & Northeastern 11-1 to win the Northeastern Invitational.
- In the polls: New Palestine is No. 1 & Yorktown No. 4 in Class 3A. Pendleton Heights is receiving votes in 4A.
