PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Brady Hunt, Delta

Hunt helped the Eagles jump out to a 6-0 record with two strong games. He had 12 points and six boards against Yorktown and followed with a 22-point, eight-rebound performance against Hamilton Heights where he was 8-8 from the floor and 5-5 from the line.

Luke Bumbalough, New Castle

Bumbalough had his third consecutive 30-point game in an 89-54 win over Shelbyville.

NEWS AND NOTES

- HHC play began last Friday with all eight teams playing their conference openers. Delta, Mt. Vernon, New Castle and New Palestine started 1-0.
- MV rallied in the fourth quarter to win a closely-contested 37-34 game over PH. Peyton Meadors had 18 points, four rebounds and four assists for MV. Christian Jones led PH with 13.
- Delta continued its strong start with a 78-31 win over Yorktown. Four Eagles were in double figures, including Josh Bryan's 21 points and 18 from Josh Greenburg. Luke Dunn had 15 for Yorktown.
- New Palestine rallied from an early 10-point deficit to beat Greenfield-Central 75-65. Maximus Gizzi had 27 points and nine boards for NP. Matthew True added 19 points. Caleb Mundell had 17 points for G-C.
- New Castle used a 52-point first half to beat Shelbyville 89-54. Luke Bumbalough had his third 30-point game of the season. He added seven boards and four assists. Nicholas Grieser added 12 for the Trojans. Zach Kuhn had 26 points and 10 boards for Shelbyville.
- Other strong performances included 29 points and 14 boards from Dawson Eastes for NP in a loss at Westfield. Delta's Brady Hunt had a 22-point game against Hamilton Heights, going 8-8 from the floor and 5-5 from the line. He added eight boards.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Katie Herron, New Palestine
