PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Josh Bryan, Delta

Bryan scored 22 points on 7-of-10 shooting to lead the Eagles to a 56-52 victory over Pendleton Heights and remain unbeaten on the season. Bryan also had five rebounds, three assists and four steals in the victory.

Luke Bumbalough, New Castle

The HHC's leading scorer again had a strong game, tallying 30 points in a 76-53 victory over Yorktown. It was his eighth 30-point outing this season. He also had six boards.

NEWS AND NOTES

- This week features a number of HHC contests, some rescheduled due to weather. Seven of the eight conference schools will play conference games this week, with Shelbyville and Greenfield-Central each playing twice in HHC play.
- Delta and Mt. Vernon meet Saturday with the HHC lead on the line. MV is seeking its first HHC title since 2016, while Delta is seeking its first since 2009.
- Last Wednesday, Delta posted a 56-52 victory over Pendleton Heights to remain unbeaten on the season. Josh Bryan had 22 points, Tyler Wilburn 13 and Brady Hunt 12 for the Eagles. Hunt also had nine boards. Damieon Warrum tallied 18 for PH.
- New Castle beat Yorktown 76-53 in the other HHC game last week. Luke Bumbalough tallied 30 points, Mason Hardwick 21 and Cole McDaniel 10 for the Trojans. Daivante Osuna had 11 points and J.J. Evans 10 for Yorktown.
- In other strong performances, Tristan Ross tallied 16 points to lead four double-figure scorers in PH's 64-58 win over University. Matthew True tallied 18 points in New Palestine's 67-60 win over Roncalli.
- At 14-0 and off to the best start in school history, Delta is ranked No. 3 in the AP Class 3A poll. The Eagles are No. 17 overall in the IBCA single-class poll.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Cameron Tabor, New Castle

Tabor tallied two double-doubles. She had 45 points and 15 boards in a win over Beech Grove and also had 17 points and 13 rebounds in an HHC win over Yorktown.

Sydnee Perry, Mt. Vernon

Perry had three solid all-around games in three victories. She averaged 12.7 points, 5.3 assists and 5.3 steals as MV went 3-0, including two HHC victories.

NEWS AND NOTES

- While New Palestine has clinched the HHC title, the battle for positioning in the conference continues in the season's final two weeks. Mt. Vernon solidified its hold on second place with two big wins - beating Shelbyville 56-29 and Greenfield-Central 48-24. Lexi Shelton led MV with 17 points, while Sydnee Perry had 14 points and eight assists for MV against Shelby. Jaidyn Tackett led the Bears with 11 points. Against G-C, Perry had 13 points and Shelton 11.
- New Castle moved into a third-place tie with a 55-28 victory over Yorktown. Cameron Tabor had 17 points and 13 boards, Alyssa Semler 13 and Karsen Morgan 12 for the Trojans. Laila Smith added 12 boards. Elizabeth Reece led the Tigers with 11 points. Tobi Bell had 10 rebounds.
- Delta beat Shelbyville 70-58 for the Eagles' second HHC win. Gracie Gilland had 22 points and Miranda Hart 20 for the Eagles. Gilland hit 9-of-11 from the floor. Olivia Knarr had 17 points and Jaidyn Tackett 14 for the Golden Bears.
- Sectional play begins next week with HHC teams at three sites. Greenfield-Central, Mt. Vernon, No. 18 New Palestine and Pendleton Heights all meet in a 4A sectional at at MV. New Castle will host a seven-team 3A sectional that also includes Delta and Yorktown. Shelbyville will travel to the Columbus East 4A sectional.
- Among top performances last week, Leah Seib had 19 points and eight boards for NP in a 69-39 win over Beech Grove. PH's Kailyn Graham scored 66 points in three games.
